Just back from our meeting with the TW-officials we have some news for you. And good ones !! But first of all, here are the dates: The Travemünde Week 2011 will be sailed from the **23rd to 31st July**. We will be sailing on course **ECHO** – on the (very old) course map below it'll be situated abouts where now is Surf/Foxtrott (much less courses nowadays) – so quite near to the slipway. This is new – will come to this in a minute. Before, let me tell you there's just one other class on **Echo** with us: Laser II sailing their World Championships there.

Our Camping is situated as last time near the Marina Mövenstein at the red circled "7" on the map below on the so called "Grünstrand". In front of 'Mövenstein' is a small car park (bluer P) and then a long stretch of Green down to the point where the beach begins. We'll camp on the northern bit as last time – but the news is, they now use the middle

bit as a facility spot for showers/toilets, our own raceoffice (!) and as a trailer park. The southern bit now will take our boats ! So the very big advantage is - we don't have this long journey down to the boats very day (formally situated at the Nordermole at the red circled "6"). They will install a slipway at the southern end of the Green / beginning of the beach. Very much like the one at the Mövenstein at the red circled "7" for all the catamarans. We share the Green and the slipway with the Europe-Class. They will be a lot of boats as they sail their Europeans. But remember how huge and long this stretch of green is. We just used a tiny bit at the northern end last time.... So I'm still very sure it'll be the very best place for a stay during a

Travemünde Week!! It's the upper bit of the shoreline facing the race areas. You will have a fantastic view over in- and outgoing boats and it should be possible to see the racing areas. The Mövenstein is situated exactly at the basis of 'Brodter Ufer/ Hermannshöhe', a cliff coast with the view over the whole Lübeck bight (5-10min by foot).

With a 10-15min walk south you are at the center of activity!! If you havn't experienced a Travemünde Week yet, ask somebody who has.. it's fantastic. There are two center stages, commentators, music and whatever else I think we'll have a great time there...

If you prefer not to camp – will just drop the word "Seestern" – be advised and be very quick !! The Travemünde Week is quite a magnet not only for sailors. So come and join in !
